What is nano bitumen?

Nano bitumen - a material used in road construction where polymers are replaced with organic nanoparticles.





Problem examples of bitumen road covering

- Lack of tensile strength
- Moisture susceptibility
- Lack of stripping resistance
- Lack of Marshal stability
- Lack of rigidity
- Bad viscosity
- Fast ageing (decreasing structural, rheological, mechanical properties)

Is it R&D?


Application to the managing authority

Funding agreement and actual procurement



After the funding agreement: PCP scheme



Challenges encountered

- Preliminary work with potential suppliers assures their participation;
- Clearly defined circular criteria must be outlined in terms and conditions;
- Suppliers attempting to offer their regular products as "circular" in order to take part in a circular procurement;
- It can be extremely difficult to convince potential "green technology" buyers that it pays off.
